### IKAL Campamento de Verano

During break, (one time a day) children can buy snacks and sweets at the snack store, so it is recommended that they bring extra money (between \$30 and \$50 pesos per day) with which they will open an account. Any money left over will be returned at the end of the camp.

### Important

Medications brought to camp by children will be administered and supervised by the camp paramedic. For safety reasons, children are not allowed to administer their own medication or have it in their possession.

1 pair flip flops, sandals or crocs

1 flashlights
